INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANTS APPLYING FOR RESERVED DEFENCE SEATS IN MEDICAL/DENTAL COLLEGES AS GOVERNMENT OF INDIA NOMINEE UNDER MINISTRY OF DEFENCE QUOTA (2024-25)

Eligibility Criteria:-

1.

(a) Scheme is open to Indian Nationals only.

(b) Only wards/widows/wives of Defence Personnel from Army, Navy & Air Force from Priority-I to Priority-IX are eligible for the scheme.

(c) Selection of candidates for Central seats reserved for Govt of India Nominee will be made on the basis of marks obtained by the student in National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET) conducted by CBSE. <u>Candidates who do not qualify the NEET should not apply</u>.

(d) Wards of civilians/civilians working in AFHQ/MoD, DRDO, wards of personnel from Para Military/CAPF are not eligible.

(e) This facility is admissible for only one member of the family once in lifetime.

(f) Candidates should have attained the age of 17 years on 31 December of the academic session in which the admission is sought for.

(g) Son of Servicemen/ Ex-servicemen who are more than 25 years of age are not eligible. Daughters if married and are not dependent, should not apply.

2. Instructions:-

The following instructions are given for information and guidance of the eligible applicants:-

(a) Applications by eligible candidate will be submitted online on KSB website i.e.<u>www.online.ksb.gov.in</u> along with supporting documents as given in Para 4 below. The last date of submitting online application will be thirty days from the date of announcement of NEET result. No offline application will be entertained. <u>Serving</u> Personnel will submit application online along with scanned copies of documents duly authenticated by OIC Records as per Para 4.

(b) A wrong or misleading entry will lead to rejection of the application.

(c) (i) Selected candidates will be informed directly by the Kendriya Sainik Board, Ministry of Defence, West Block-IV, Wing No. 7, RK Puram, New Delhi-110066 through email and telephonically about the date of counseling.

(ii) Selected candidates who want to appear/not appear in counseling should send his/her willingness/ unwillingness telephonically as well as by the e-mail ID: <u>jd.cksb-mod@gov.in</u> and by post also within specified date given by KSB Sectt. Format of Willingness/Unwillingness certificate is attached as **Annexure I & II**.

(iii) Candidature of those selected candidates who fail to appear for the counseling on specified date will be cancelled and his / her seat will be passed to the next candidate in merit*.

*(If for unavoidable reason, the date of counseling is not as per the convenience of the candidate, he/she has to informed in writing (e-mail) requesting for a subsequent date. Such extension of counseling date is permitted only once).

Any candidate to whom MBBS/BDS seat is offered but he/she fails to (iv) give willingness/unwillingness certificate by specific date mentioned by KSB Sectt, his/her candidature will be cancelled and his/her seat will be passed to the next candidate in merit. (d) Nomination made will be subject to the candidate fulfilling the admission requirements of the Institution/University concerned.

(e) Candidature and admission of an applicant, admitted on the basis of the information furnished by him/her and subsequently found to have made any false statement in any respect, will be cancelled and will be expelled from the college. Fees and other dues paid by the candidate shall NOT be refunded.

(f) Candidate admitted against the reserved seats will have to execute a Bond with the Government of India, Ministry of Health or the State Government or the Administration of Union Territory as the case may be to serve the Government concerned for the specified period after qualifying for registration as a Medical/Dental Graduate.

(g) If selected candidate is refused admission by the Medical/Dental College concerned due to non-fulfillment of admission requirements he/she will not have any claim for his/her transfer or admission to some other Medical/Dental college.

(h) The seat offered will be final and no request for change will be entertained. Candidates who fail to send their acceptance by the prescribed date will forfeit their nomination.

(j) Applications are to be submitted online only for MBBS and BDS courses on KSB Sectt website <u>www.online.ksb.gov.in</u> as per online format of application form.

(k) The attested photocopies of the supporting documents both by Director, Rajya/Zila Sainik Board and OIC Records, in case of actual and legitimate children (including validly adopted sons/daughters prior to the death of the deceased), are to be uploaded with application form.

(I) The selection within Priority-V will be strictly in the order of Gallantry awards.

(m) The Candidates must clearly mention the Priority in his/her application as listed below:-

Priority-I :Widows/Wards of Defence personnel killed in action.

Priority-II :Wards of disabled in action and *boarded out* from service.

Priority-III :Widows/Wards of Defence personnel who died while in service with death *attributable to military service*.

Priority-IV :Wards of disabled in service and **boarded out** with disability **attributable to military service**.

Priority-V : Wards of Ex-Servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards:-

Priority VI : Wards of Ex-Servicemen.

Priority VII : Wives of:

(i) Defence personnel disabled in action and boarded out from service.

(ii) Defence personnel disabled in action and boarded out with disability attributable to military service.

(iii) Ex-servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards.

Priority VIII : Wards of Serving Personnel.

Priority IX : Wives of Serving Personnel.

(n) All Eligibility Certificates will be recommended by the ZSB of the individual soldier/airmen/sailor/JCOs/Officers and countersigned by the Director RSBs.In case of serving personnel only (Under Priority-V, VII, VIII & IX) the eligibility certificate to be signed by CO/OC Unit or OIC Records.

(o) Litigation if any, are restricted to jurisdiction of Delhi Courts only.

(p) Instructions given above are to be used as guidelines only, these are subject to change without notice as per Medical Council of India/Ministry of Health rulings issued from time to time.

3. Criteria for Drawing Merit List/Selection

(a) Merit list will be prepared priority wise and within each priority as per the NEET score. The merit list will be uploaded on the website on finalization.

(b) The allocation of seats will be on priority basis, first the candidate in Priority I will be accommodated and the left over seats from Priority I will be given to Priority II and so on.

4. CHECK LIST FOR DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED WITH THE APPLICATION

FORM. The following documents are to be uploaded with the application form:-

(a) Self attested photocopy of the marks-sheet of Matriculation examination.

(b) Self attested photocopy of the marks-sheet of 10+2 or equivalent examination.

(d) Eligibility certificate will be duly signed by ZSB and countersigned by Director RSBs. For serving personnel in priority V, VII, VIII & IX eligibility certificate to be signed only by CO/OC Unit or OIC Records.

(e) Self-attested photocopies of Education Entitlement Card, latest Pension Payment Order, Special/Liberalized family pension, Battle Casualty Certificate, Casualty Indicating Disability or documentary proof of Gallantry Award (copy of Gazette Notification and Part II Order), as applicable.

(f) Passport size photograph.

NOT ELIGIBLE CRITERIA

Priority-II Wards of disabled in action and boarded out from service

Not-Eligible

All Armed Forces Personnel who are injured in action or circumstances mentioned in AO/1/2003/MP and declared Battle casualty, despite having disability being retained in service and retired subsequently under Army Rule 13 3 III (i), 13 3 III (ii) or took premature retirement under own request under Army Rule 13 3 III (iv) and are in receipt of **war injury element** or liberalized disability element **their wards are not entitled for P-II as per Para 11 (Appx 'C')** but will only be considered as ESM hence can apply under P-VI.

Priority-III Wards/ Widows of Defence Personnel who died while in service with death attributable to Military Service.

Not-Eligible

All the Armed Forces Personal who died in service under condition/circumstances mentioned in cat 'A' (i.e Death or disability due to natural causes neither attributable to nor aggravated by military service as determined by the competent medical authorities) of Para 4.1 of GOI MoD letter 1 (2)/97/1 D (Pen-C) dated 31st Jan 2001 (Appx 'C') and its subsequent amendment letters and their eligible family members are in receipt of Ordinary family pension (OFP) their wards are *not eligible* for claiming Priority-III.

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PRIORITY- IV Wards of Disabled in Service and Boarded out with Disability Attributable to Military Service

Not-Eligible

As per letter DESW, MoD letter No. 6(1)/2017/D(Res.II) dated 21 May 2018 Appx 'A') who should be *not entitled to avail* the benefits under Priority-IV (i.e. Wards of disabled in service and boarded out from the service with disability Attributable to Military Service) are mentioned below:-

(a) All Armed Forces Personnel who were retired/discharged from service on fulfilling the conditions of his enrolment or having reached the stage at which discharge may be enforced as per Army Rule 13 3 III(i) and entitled to disability element as per Para 8 (Appx 'C') are not eligible for Priority-IV.

(b) All Armed Forces Personnel who were retired/discharged from **service** on completion of period of army service only, there being no vacancy in the Reserve as per Army Rule 13 3 III (ii) are not eligible for Priority-IV.

(c) All Armed Forces Personnel who were retired/discharged from service at his own request before fulfilling the conditions of his enrolment as per Army Rule 13 III(iv) are not eligible for Priority-IV.

(d) All Armed Forces Personnel who were retired/ discharged from service in any circumstances having not attributable and not aggravated **(NANA)** shall not be eligible for Priority-IV.

PRIORITY-V Wards of Ex-Servicemen and serving personnel who are in receipt of Gallantry Awards

Not-Eligible

All the Armed Forces personnel Serving/Ex-Servicemen who are inreceipt of Distinguished service Awards in their service, their wards are not considered in Priority-Vas per letter DESW, MoD letter No. 6(1)/2017/0(Res.II) dated 21 May 2018.



IMPLEMENTATION OF THE GOVERNMENT DECISION ON THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF FIFTH CPC REGARDING DISABILITY PENSION/WAR INJURY PENSION/SPECIAL FAMILY PENSION/LIBERALISE FAMILY PENSION/DEPENDENT PENSION/ LIBERALIZED DEPENDENT FOR THE ARMED FORCES OFFICERS AND PERSONNEL BELOW OFFICER RANK

4.1 For determining the pensionary benefits for death of disability under different circumstances due to attributable /aggravated causes, the cases will be broadly categorized as follows :-

Category 'A'

Death or disability due to natural causes neither attributable to nor aggravated by military service as determined by the competent medical authorities. Examples would be ailments of nature of constitutional diseases as assessed by medical authorities, chronic ailments like heart and renal diseases, prolonged illness, accidents while not on duty.

Category 'B'

Death or disability due to causes which are accepted as attributable to or aggravated by military service as determined by the competent medical authorities. Disease contracted because of continued exposure to a hostile work environment, subject to extreme weather conditions or occupational hazards resulting in death or disability would be examples.

Category 'C'

Death or disability due to accidents in the performance of duties such as :-

(i) Accidents while travelling on duty in Governments Vehicles or public/private transport.

- (ii) Accidents during air journeys.
- (iii) Mishaps at sea while on duty.
- (iv) Electrocution while on duty, etc.

(v) Accidents during participation in organized sports events/adventure activities/expeditions/training.

Category 'D'

Death or disability due to acts of violence/attack by terrorists, antisocial elements, etc whether on duty or other than operational duty or even when not on duty. Bomb blasts in public places or transport, indiscriminate shooting incidents in public, etc. would be covered under this category, besides death/disability occurring while employed in the aid of civil power in dealing with natural calamities. (i) Unintentional killing by own troops during the course of duty in an operational area (Included vide GOI letter No 2(1)/2011-D(Pen/Policy) dt 03 Feb 2011 & cases already settled prior to date of issue of this letter will not be reported).

(ii) Electrocution/attacks by wild animals and snake bite/drowning during the course of action in counter insurgency/war (Included vide GOI letter No 2(1)/2011-D(Pen/Policy) dt 03 Feb 2011& cases already settled prior to date of issue of this letter will not be reported).

(iii) Accidental death/injury sustained due to natural calamities such as flood, avalanches, land slide, cyclone, fire and lightening or drowning in river while performing operational duties/movement in action against enemy forces and armed hostilities in operational area to include deployment on international border or line of control (Included vide GOI letter No 2(1)/2011-D(Pen/Policy) dt 03 Feb 2011& cases already settled prior to date of issue of this letter will not be reported).

Category 'E'

Death or disability arising as a result of :-

- (a) Enemy action in international war.
- (b) Action during deployment with a peace keeping mission abroad.
- (c) Border skirmishes.

(d) During laying or clearance of mines including enemy mines as also minesweeping operations.

(e) On account of accidental explosions of mines while laying operationally oriented mine-field or lifting or negotiating mine-field laid by the enemy or own forces in operational areas near international borders or the line of control.

(f) War like situations, including cases which are attributable to/aggravated by :-

(i) Death or disability arising as a result of poisoning of water by enemy agents while deployed in operational area in active hostilities. (Included vide GOI letter No 2(1)/2011-D(Pen/Policy) dt 03 Feb 2011 & cases already settled prior to date of issue of this letter will not be reported).

(ii) Extremist acts, exploding mines etc, while on way to an operational area.

(iii) Battle inoculation training exercises or demonstration with live ammunition will cover the following :-

(aa) Flying operation involved in rehearsing of war plans and implementation OP instructions inclusive of international exercises.

(ab) All combat and Tactical Sorties in preparation of war.

(ac) Valley flying and missions involving operating at Ultra Low Levels.

(ad) All operational missions undertaken during peace like Special operations, Live ORP, Reece, Elint, Survey and induction trials of new weapons.

(ae) Missions undertaken in support of troops and security force deployed in forward areas.

(af) Flying missions involving landings on the ALGs." (Included vide GOI Letter No 21(11)/2006-6(Pen-c)/PC dt 08 Sep 2009 and even No dt 05 Mar 2010 for ser No (iii) Parra (aa) to (af)).

(iv) Kidnapping by extremists while on operational duty.

(g) An act of violence /attack by extremists, antisocial elements, etc. while on operational duty.

(h) Action against extremists, antisocial elements, etc. Death/disability while employed in the aid of civil power in quelling agitation, riots or revolt by demonstrators will be covered under this category.

(j) Operations specially notified by the Govt from time to time.
